On this first Sunday of Advent, we light the candle of hope. Isaiah gives us a vision of a kingdom yet to come where everything has been made new and where creation is at peace: "A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit. The Spirit of the LORD will rest on him – the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the LORD – and he will delight in the fear of the LORD" (Isaiah 11:1-3). We light this candle of hope as a sign of our waiting and expectation for the coming Christ.

Let us pray. Emanuel, God with us, in this Advent season, we confess how difficult it is to slow down. We don't want to wait patiently for anything, and instead we buy into the busyness of the season, leading many of us to feel a lack of joy and a lack of hope. When we look at the world around us, it's hard to feel hopeful about the world, about our nation, about ourselves. We are surrounded by death, destruction, and pain, and we long for a day when your promised kingdom comes to make all things new. Give us hope that this day is indeed coming and help us to rest in this because your promises are always true. Amen. (-from "Be Not Afraid," Advent 1 Liturgy)


