Candle Lighting

As we anticipate the birth of Jesus Christ, we light candles of hope, love, and peace as reminders of the promise that Emmanuel is our God with us and that God graciously gives us these gifts even if they sometimes come in ways that are mysterious to us. On this fourth Sunday of Advent, we light the candle of peace. We wait for God's promises of peace on earth and good will to all. We pray that God's peace would break through our restless hearts and lead us into unity with one another. In longing and trust, we light this candle of peace.

Let us pray: Emmanuel, God with us, in this Advent season we confess that we are a broken and prideful people. We fail to live as you have called us to live - choosing anger over patience, self-righteousness over understanding, conflict over peace. We give in too easily to our more selfish instincts, instead of living out of your mercy and love. Our hearts are wrapped up in fear and anxiety, instead of resting securely in your promises. Forgive us when we think we know better. Assure us once more that you hold all things in your hands, and that we can rest in you. Bring peace into our weary and troubled hearts. We pray this in Jesus' name, Amen.


