# Offering:

This Week: **World Renew** is working with their global networks in the region to respond to the needs of vulnerable families impacted by the conflict in Ukraine. They are supporting their peer organizations by providing essential items for people fleeing for safety to neighboring countries. In Slovakia, they are providing temporary shelters, emergency food, and emergency non-food items such as blankets, linens, mattresses, and basic hygiene items. In Romania and Poland, they are responding with health support by supplying health packs that will be used by local health centers.

Next Week: The **Au Sable Institute** prepares students for careers in solving the earth's toughest environmental challenges. Through hands-on learning in the outdoors, engaging professors who integrate faith into their instruction, and a supportive community of friends, they inspire and educate people to serve, protect, and restore God's earth. They have over 50 Partner Colleges nationwide including Calvin University, Cornerstone University, and Dordt University.
