Today's Offering: *Disability Concerns* is now part of *Thrive*, the denomination's agency that covers race relations, diversity, chaplaincy, disability concerns, faith formation, pastor church resources, safe church, social justice, and worship. Thrive strives to promote and foster relationships, communities, and societies where everybody belongs and everybody serves by assisting churches, agencies, institutions, and leadership within the RCA and CRCNA.

Leadership Board Updates: One of the Leadership Board's responsibilities is to initiate and complete the process for council nominations and selection each year. At the Full Council's direction, we are working with Pastor Tim on new strategies for identifying, recruiting and equipping elders and deacons, with a view towards implementation in early 2024. Please be in prayer about this process and begin thinking about whether God is calling you or someone you know at Second to this important ministry in 2024.

Second CRC's Expansion Anniversary: In 2002 an expansion plan was approved, and a major construction project was launched at our church. An addition was to include a new office area, kitchen, multi-purpose North Hall, and atrium on the main level. The lower level was to include nurseries, classroom space, along with meeting, music, and storage areas. Also, the existing structure and sanctuary were to have air conditioning installed. The addition was dedicated on January 12, 2003. A 15-minute slide presentation will be running in the atrium and North Hall before and after church today, Sunday, October 15, commemorating the 20th anniversary of this project.
